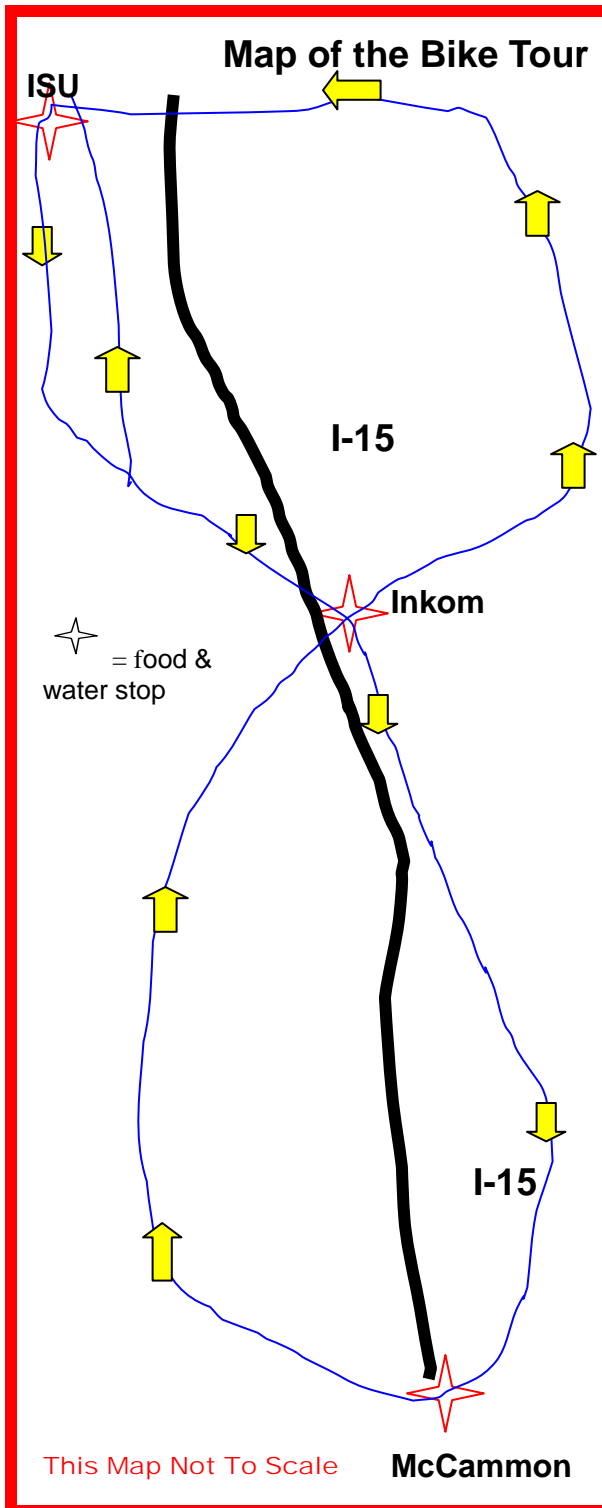

The Bike Tour

It begins and ends at the Idaho State University Pond Student Union Building (PSUB) parking lot on the corner of Fifth and Humboldt (that's across from Taco Bell on South Fifth) in Pocatello. There are three mileage/route choices for this fantastic ride.

Typical weather in SE Idaho at this time of year is cool mornings. But plan on a magnificent ride in warm sunshine by mid-morning. The roads include beautiful views of autumn foliage in full explosions of color.

All routes begin going south, through Ross Park and down through the Portneuf Gap. The 16.5-mile route goes as far south as Fort Hall Mine Road. Then, riders take Old Highway 91 back to ISU to the start line.

The 32-mile route takes you south to Inkom and the 100K takes you south to McCammon along South Portneuf and Marsh Creek Roads. Both of the longer routes return to Pocatello via Inkom along Rapid Creek, Hoot Owl, and Buckskin Roads. These roads include a gradual 10-mile climb to the top of Buckskin. (The last mile is a little steep). Then, enjoy a glorious 6.5-mile downhill into Pocatello. You won't be sorry if you choose either of these routes. Participants from previous years rave about this Tour.

Rides begin casually between 8:00-8:30am
100 K (60 mile) •• 32 Mile ••16.5 Mile

Other Things You Need To Know

HELMETS ARE REQUIRED!

Each ride is supported with sag wagons, food, water, restroom stops (at 30 & 60 miles), and mapped routes.

We **RECOMMEND** that you bring your own tire pump, spare tube, water bottle, and appropriate clothing.

All Riders **MUST** check in on the day of the ride.
