**EVENTS**

**Packet pickup and late registration: Friday, July 5, 5:00- 10:00 p.m.** Scott's Ski & Sports, 224 N. Main St. in Pocatello. From I-15, take the Clark/Center St. exit. Take Clark down the hill and into town. After crossing 4<sup>th</sup> Ave., get in the right lane, veer left on Pocatello Ave. (Clark ends there), take an immediate right on Center, and go through the rail yard tunnel. Turn right on Main; Scott's is on your right a block and a half down. From I-86, take the West Pocatello/Highway 30 exit. Turn right at the light at Hawthorne. This becomes Arthur. Turn left on Clark then left on Main.

**Truckerville Time Trial: Saturday, July 6, 8:00 a.m.** Take I-86 west of Pocatello to the Arbon Valley exit. Parking is in the back lot of Bannock Peak Truck Stop. Out-and-back course is flat with one freeway overpass and fair to good pavement. It can be windy! Start order: juniors, men 4/5, women 4, women 35+, men 45+, men 55+, women 1/2/3, men 35+, men 3, men pro/1/2. Start times will be posted at Scott's by 11:00 p.m. Friday.

**Holt Arena Criterium: Saturday, July 6, 2:00 p.m.** From Clark or Center Streets, turn south on 15<sup>th</sup> Ave. to the Idaho State University campus. Holt Arena is on your left. Follow signs to parking. Course is 1km in length with good pavement, 7 corners and a short hill. Start order same as for time trial.

**Marsh Valley Mash Road Race: Sunday, July 7, 8:00 a.m.** Take I-15 south to McCammon (about 20 miles from Pocatello). Take exit 47, turn east on Highway 30, and turn right on the business loop into McCammon. Turn right on 9<sup>th</sup> St. Course is a rolling, 17.5 mile loop on county roads with good to fair pavement, one short climb, and little traffic.

**Awards Party: Sunday, July 7, 12:30 to 2:00 p.m.** Centennial Park in McCammon. Free food and drink.
