STAGES

Marsh Valley Road Race: Saturday, June 27, 9:00 a.m. (START LOCATION at Marsh Valley High School!) Take I-15 to Arimo (about 30 miles south of Pocatello). Take exit 40, and go east a quarter of a mile to England's Sinclair Station. Turn left and go about 2 miles north to Marsh Valley High School. Course is the same as in past years: rolling, 17.5 mile loop on county roads with good pavement, one climb, and little traffic. Neutral water available in feed zone on east side of course.

5th Street Bagelry Time Trial: Saturday, June 27, 6:30 p.m. Take I-86 west of Pocatello to the Rainbow Road exit. Park on the west frontage road extension. Out-and-back course is flat with good pavement. Within each class, riders will start in reverse order of GC at 30-second intervals. Start times will be posted at the conclusion of the road race and at the time trial start venue.

Holt Arena Criterium: Sunday, June 28, 8:00 a.m. From Clark or Center Streets, turn south on 15th Ave. to the ISU campus. Holt Arena is on your left. Follow signs to parking. Course is 1.5 km in length with good pavement, several corners and a short hill.
